Each year, Ivy Tech Community College awards 10 non-need based Vocational Education Scholarships to High School Seniors from Clay, Greene, Parke, Putnam, Sullivan, Vermillion, and Vigo counties in Indiana and Clark, Crawford, and Edgar counties in Illinois. The amount of the scholarship is valued at \$2000 (\$500 each semester).

To be eligible for this scholarship the student must:

Be a High School Senior enrolled in a vocational education program

Have a minimum of a 3.0/4.0 cumulative grade point average in vocational education courses and a minimum of a 2.0/4.0 cumulative grade point average in all other courses.

To apply for this scholarship the student must:

Complete the scholarship application (over)

Complete an Application for Admission (see Guidance Counselor)

Submit an official copy of High School Transcript (must be in a sealed envelope)

Write a short essay (2-4 paragraphs; 1 page maximum) entitled: "Why I Believe I Deserve This Scholarship and Why I Chose My Intended Major."

Enroll as a Full-Time student at Ivy Tech Community College in Terre Haute for the Fall semester

Maintain a minimum 2.0 college grade point average to remain eligible

To be considered, all application materials MUST be received by MARCH 10th.
